INTERVIEW

The IG News interviewed Mr. Domingos Torres, National Director of the School Social Project Department of the Angolan Ministry of Education on the impact of the ISF Inclusive Games.

In his opinion it is a very important event because it is the first one and the expectations are really high. The games provide the opportunity for sharing experiences, socializing and learn the organization "know how".

Angola has already started tracing the path for inclusion, as it has a Paralympic Athletics team, too. When competitions happen, all athletes, impaired or not, participate, being the only difference the necessary adaptations for the impaired athletes.

The goal of the visit is to absorb the way inclusion can become part of the Angolan School Sport plan and then replicate it, so that it reaches more schools and students.
